## Record of Meeting and General Meeting Minutes

11 February 2017

Dennes Point Hall

A presentation to a meeting of 26 people (including eight non-FONB members) was given from 2.30-3.45pm.

Presenters were:

- Huon Aquaculture (Jane Gallichan and David Whyte) detailing the proposed expansion of leases by Huon Aquaculture in Storm Bay off North Bruny; and noting their support for the Tasmanian Government to determine a policy for sustainable fish farming in Storm Bay
- Gerard Castles (Business Consultant) detailing a case study on the Rat Bay campaign re light and noise pollution by Tassal over 10 years

### 2. Storm Bay Fish Farm Proposal

The meeting resolved unanimously:

'That the Executive Committee act on behalf of Friends of North Bruny to work with other community groups around Storm Bay to bring to the attention of the Premier, Fisheries Minister and the Marine Farming Planning Review Panel the need for an agreed plan for sustainable fish farming in Storm Bay and the D'Entrecasteau; and, asks that this be resolved before there are any expansion to the leases in Storm Bay' (Garth Pope/Ian Locke)

### 3. Road Speeds

The meeting resolved unanimously:

'That given the CWA Hall/Killora/Dennes Point loop is frequently utilised by runners, cyclists, walkers as well as cars, the speed limits be reduced to 60km/hr except in townships where it be 40km/hr; the signage reflect the shared nature of the road; speed humps be included where appropriate; and, this agreement be taken to Dept. of State Growth to seek implementation" (Lynne Pope/Veronica McAfee).
